The Philippines has the largest population of Christians of any Southeast Asian nation, with 92%, the vast majority being Catholic. God has positioned His Church in the Philippines to dynamically impact all the ethnic people groups in their own nation while also scattering outside their own nation to unreached peoples across Southeast Asia and beyond. God has been mobilizing His Church in the Philippines over the last few decades for the Great Commission. An important strategy has emerged of scattering 1 million Filipino overseas foreign workers (OFW's), who are devoted believers. Using this work related mechanism of influencing families and cities among unreached peoples across the Middle East and Asia. Let's seek the Lord for an increase of spiritual growth in the Church in the Philippines that leads to an increase in mission mobilization.

ABANDONED DEVOTION IN THE CHURCH:

- An increase of emphasis on the Great Commission within local ministries, enabling every disciple to understand the Great Commission from Scripture.
- Prayer for a paradigm shift from "mission" being on the periphery (a dept or committee) of churches and denominations to being the core identity of the Filipino body of Christ.
