ABANDONED DEVOTION IN THE CHURCH:

- Believers and local churches cultivating the depth of spiritual life necessary to influence sometimes hostile peoples for the Kingdom of God
- Believers and local churches having their identity rooted firmly in Christ alone and not what they do for God (Ephesians 2:8-9). Finding their value and measure of success in Jesus not in worldly markers.
- Believers and local churches growing in spiritual maturity – coming into the fullness that God has made available through the death and resurrection of Christ.

GROWING MISSION MOBILIZATION IN THE CHURCH:

- The body of Christ in Egypt arising with a burning vision of obeying Jesus' command to "disciple all ethnic groups (Matt. 28:19)" across Egypt and surrounding nations.
- Every local ministry in Egypt becoming an effective, anointed "Great Commission Ministry" – ministry embodying the emphasis on the Great Commission through educating, inspiring and activating their members in their roles.
- Every local ministry viewing mission mobilization as a core, natural process of true discipleship, not an added, subsequent thing.
